In accordance with Aquatic Pesticide Permit # AI-7-23-44 as issued by the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) beginning on or after July 12, 2023, the City of Oneida intends to apply a larvicide along select street and into its municipal storm water collection system for the purpose of controlling mosquito's. Zoecon Altosid Larvicide Liquid Growth Regulator will be used along select street at an application rate of 4 ounces per acre, and Zoecon Altosid XR Extended Residual Briquets (EPA Reg. No. 2724-421) will be used at an application rate not to one (1) briquet per stormwater drainage inlet. The active ingredient is 5.0% Methoprene for Zoecon Altosid Liquid, and 2.1% Methoprene for Zoecon Altosid XR Briquets. The US Environmental Protection Agency toxicity category is "Caution". The application will take place between July 12, 2023 - August 15, 2023. The target pest is mosquito larva. The larvicide will be applied by hand into water drainage inlets. A database, as well as map of the locations of storm water inlets are on file at the Office of the City Engineer, 109 N. Main Street, Oneida, NY 13421 and are available for viewing during normal business hours, 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday thru Friday. 
