## Protect It and Inspect It

#### Do:

 Have your system inspected (in general) every three- years by a licensed contractor and have the tank pumped, when necessary, generally every three to five years.

## Think at the Sink:

#### Don't:

- Pour cooking grease or 011 down the sink or toilet.
- Rimie coffee grounds Into the sink.
- Pour household Ghemicals down,the s1nk or flush them.

#### Do:

- .. Eliminate or limit the use of **a garbs** ge disposal.
- Properly dispose of coffee grounds & food.
- Put grease in a container to harden before discat ding in th.e trash

## Don't Overload the Commode:

• Flush non-degradable products or diemicals, such as feminine hygiene products, condoms, dental floss, diapers, cigarette butts, cat litter, paper towels, pharmaceuticals.

## Shield Your Field:

## Don't:

- Park or dnve on your drainfield. The weight can damage the drain lines.
- Plant trees or shrubs too close to *your* drainfield, roots can grow into your system an.d clog it.

## Do:

 Consult a septic service professional to advise you of the proper distance for planting trees and shrubs, depending on your septic tank location.

## Don't Strain Your Drain:

## Don't

• Concentrate your water use *by* using your dishwasher, shower, washing machine, and toilet at the same time. Alf that extra water can really strain your septic system,

## Do:

- Stagger the use of water-generating appliances. This can be helpful especially rf your system has not been pumped in a long time.
- Become more <u>wate1 efficient</u> by fixing plumbing leaks and consider installing bathroom and kitchen faucet a.erators and water-efficient products.
