## CITY OF ONEIDA COMMUNITY GARDENER'S AGREEMENT (April 1, 2025-October 31, 2025)

- I will work to keep the garden a happy, secure and enjoyable place where all participants can garden and socialize peacefully in a neighborly manner.
- I will respect the safety of all gardeners, their plots, and their guests. Abusive, profane or discriminatory language and dangerous or risky actions will not be tolerated.
- Guests and visitors, including children, may enter the garden only if they are accompanied by a registered plot gardener. Children must always be supervised and registered gardeners are responsible for the behavior of their guests.
- **<u>NO PETS</u>** will be allowed in the garden.
- Gardeners agree to keep the garden, paths and garden edges clean and free of weeds, diseased plants, insect infested plants and over-ripe vegetables. No plants or supports may exceed 6 feet in height.
- Herbicides of ANY type are NOT allowed in the garden.
- Ripe produce must be picked regularly, every few days if necessary, during peaks.
- It is strictly prohibited to take food or plants from any other garden plots.
- Anything you bring from home must be taken back with you every time.
- Unattended watering is not allowed. All spigots must be turned off before you leave the garden.
- No outside or household trash will be allowed to be left at the community garden. The compost area is for green waste ONLY.
- Garden plots must be cleaned up by October 31<sup>st</sup>. This means all plants have been removed, and the soil is clean and level.
- Forfeited and abandoned plots will be cleared. Any produce will be donated to charity.
- I understand that there will be an annual fee of \$20 for EACH individual plot I use, payable by March 14, 2025, to the City of Oneida. This payment must be completed before the gardening season begins.
- 'Renting out' or 'leasing' any part of a plot is prohibited. Anyone helping with your plot must sign the Gardener's Agreement.
- I agree to dedicate 3 hours of volunteer time this season to the overall maintenance of the garden (not including time spent in your own individual plot).
- I understand that this is a community garden and, for us to succeed, gardener support is needed to maintain the site and good neighbor relations.
