#### **ONEIDA CITY OFFICES CLOSED**

Our offices will be closed on Monday, November 11, 2024 in observance of Veterans Day.



On October 1, 2024, a Local Law was introduced to amend the annual income ranges for senior citizens as set forth in Chapter 165 of the Oneida City Code and to create a Cold War Veterans Exemption. This law was adopted on November 6, 2024.

Thank you Councilor Andrea Hitchings and City Assessor Rebecca Lennon for working to make this change and to the Mayor, City Manager, and Council for your support.

As the deadline for the 2025 taxes was May 1 of 2024, any changes with this local law will take effect with the 2026 taxes. The paperwork will need to be submitted to the Assessor by May 1, 2025.


