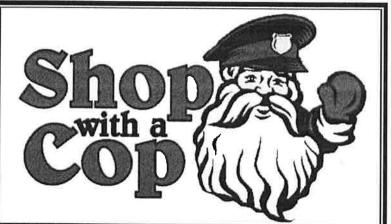

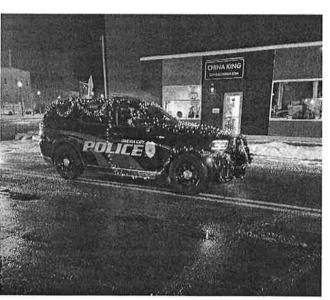
Overtime: The Department had a total of \$33,298 in overtime for the month of December before any reimbursements were requested. The Department endeavors to keep overtime costs responsible while providing the best quality services.

Activity: The PBA hosted the annual shop with a cop event and we participated in the Holiday Light Parade festival. As a matter of continued exceptional service, Oneida Police handled 744 service incidents, issued 52 traffic tickets and 63 parking tickets, and made 41 arrests.
