ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the furnishing of all labor and material necessary for Higinbotham Brook Culvert Replacement Project will be received by the City of Oneida, 109 North Main Street, Oneida, NY 13421 until 10:00 am local time Wednesday, January 10, 2024 at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids will be received for the following Contract:

Contract No. 1 – Higinbotham Brook Culvert Replacement Project (Phase 1)

This Contract is for Phase 1 of the Higinbotham Brook Culvert Replacement. This project will replace the culvert carrying Higinbotham Brook which begins west of Main Street and extends to east of Elizabeth Street. The existing culvert is approximately 1000 feet in length and consists of varying sizes of concrete box and arch shapes. The proposed culvert will be a 78-inch diameter, circular aluminized steel pipe. Roadway reconstruction will be required at Main Street and Elizabeth Street including work on the public utilities.

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The attention of Bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract.

The right is reserved to waive any informalities in the Bid and to reject any or all Bids.

This project is solely funded and administered by the City of Oneida. While encouraged, the project does not include specific requirements for D/M/WBE subcontractor participation or workforce participation.
