WHEREAS, in 1872, J. Sterling Morton proposed to the Nebraska Board of Agriculture that a special day be set aside for the planting of trees known now as Arbor Day, and

WHEREAS, Arbor Day was first observed with the planting of more than a million trees in Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, April 26, 2024 is the 152<sup>nd</sup>Anniversary of Arbor Day and is now observed throughout the Nation and the world, **and** 

WHEREAS, trees can reduce the erosion of our topsoil by wind and water, cut heating and cooling costs, moderate the temperature, clean the air, produce lifegiving oxygen and provide habitat for wildlife; and

WHEREAS, trees are a renewable resource giving us paper, wood, fuel and countless other wood products; and

WHEREAS, trees in our City increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, beautify our community and are a source of joy and spiritual renewal; and now therefore,

I, Rick Rossi, Mayor do hereby proclaim May 9, 2025 as:

" Firbor Day"

in the City of Oneida and urge all residents to celebrate Arbor Day and to support efforts to protect our trees, parks, and woodlands; and I further encourage all residents to plant trees to promote the well-being of our environment and community, for generations to come.
